Operation Grain Harvest Assist - South Australia

A nationwide operation has been launched, aiming to bolster the supply of regional workers to help deliver this year's grains harvest, and relieve pressure on farming communities. With the lack of backpackers and the inability of casual workers to cross borders, grain farmers are desperate for help to harvest their crops. Former full-time ADF, Reserve, Defence Industry, friends and family are mobilising under 'Operation Grain Harvest Assist' to work on grain farms throughout Australia.

In South Australia the grain harvest runs over November and December, with some jobs continuing into January. Willing workers are required to work directly for grain farmers to operate harvesters, drive chaser bins, and work as general hands. Further grain handling jobs are available principally with Viterra and T-Ports. Previous experience is not required, however a good level of health, a willingness to learn, and resilience is essential. A commitment of two weeks is preferred.

The joint operation between 'Operation Grain Harvest Assist' and Regional Development Australia (RDA) aims to link willing workers to sites where they are needed. The focus of activity is the Eyre Peninsula, Yorke Peninsula and Mid-North and Murray Mallee.
